*What would be useful to achieve, in terms of a) movement-building b) intersectionality and working with social movements c) impact on the system*

- coordinate between groups, agree digital strategy to communicate in advance, give visibility to climate care uprising
- climate movement should connect with other social movements --> give visibility + share tools ==> it's not only about solidarity/help but their fight is actually linked to the climate crisis
- need a reason to move, also need people to join who are not involved yet, bigger companies that are responsible for climate crisis and are making a profit in current crisis --> recognise same 'enemy' with other movement and concentrate energy
- not to mobilize 'intersectionally' but create bigger intersectional discourse? long term intersectionality
- not clear how people can join/take part, what tasks to give to new people
- target new people: stronger message --> many problems have same source ==> not only attack but give answers/solutions: food/health/'green' jobs
- impact on system: more people need to realise climate change will affect/affects them, it discriminates against marginalised people
- diversify geographically, expand the movement in Eastern Europe
- more compassion in movement --> within activists ==> need to be able to last **long term**
- Objective for autumn: getting people to realize by the end of the autumn that the same reason we are in this mess (social crisis) is the same reason for the climate crisis - the system we live in
