Concerns:

- That people agree intersectionality is important but that no one plans anything for the JusticeS moment, and the actions will not be internationally strong and coordinated.
 - **saying instead of doing intersectionality**
- There is a weird connection between the JusticeS and the GA - The narrative is not really coherent and politically strong
 - possible solution: not going back to Climate with GA immediately but taking a breather/break after the JusticeS - and coming back in November/December with the signing of the GA and a possible international action day in December (5-year anniversary of Paris Agreement)
- Radical Solidarity doesn't sound that political (as in, helping out is not the same as trying to fix the root of all of this social and climate crisis)
- We don't really have objectives for what we want to achieve with this wave

Excited:

- To the possible coalitions that we can build and building the movement of movements. Possibly with the GA signature
- Concrete intersectional work on concrete projects (most obvious possibility: actively supporting ongoing struggles *in a way they find useful*)
