What are your concerns and your agreements relative to the framework presented?

Concerns:

- That people agree intersectionality is important but that no one plans anything for the JusticeS moment, and the actions will not be internationally strong and coordinated.
- There is a weird connection between the JusticeS and the GA
- The narrative is not really coherent and politically strong

A: From Poland, worried about intersectionality homophobia (for example)

R: Worst would be to prepare for this because not so many activist groups that can actually work on this, so we need to overcome this, and need to overcome internal struggles.

K: Worries of superficial solidarity (just adding to name or narrative but not organizing),

T: FFF Germany, this is important, working to make it more diverse.

A: Worried about low levels of mobilization in eastern Europe.

R: People aren't wanting to become activists, if they do become activists they focus on government and social issues as it doesn't touch us so directly. Slovakia has issues with mafias, oligarchs, etc. which people are more focused on. Ukraine, Hungary, Czech are similar.

Excited:

- To the possible coligations that we can build and building the movement of movements. GA signature
- like the idea that climate movement needs to step up to play a supportive role in coordinating international movements (as we are the best placed to do that) and thus enacting real intersectional work rather than trying to bring others into our work. Like frame of "Recover" as way to create an open frame
